South Carolina house bill 3040 introduced this year would require that passengers younger than 7 years of age must be secured in an appropriate child passenger restraint system. The bill calls for child seats approved by the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration and secured to the motorcycle by lap and shoulder belts. The law would also apply to moped passengers.
