This is the longest running motorcycle event in the USA. This is the original Midnight Timed Run which was started by the Crotona Motorcycle Club in 1911. 1999 was our first year hosting this event, and it was a great success. It is a simple timed run that is a major challenge due to the fact it is run at night in February. A timed run is an event that requires entrants to maintain a prescribed speed over each section of the route. It's open to all riders.
